### Parking

Free on-site parking is available on the east and west sides of the building, as well as underground via the east parking lot entrance. **At peak times, it may be difficult to find a parking spot;** therefore, please leave ample time prior to your class start time in the event that parking is limited. Additional free parking can be found off-site in the following locations:

- At Mackin Park on King Edward Street
- On Begin Street
- On James Avenue
- On the north side of Brunette Avenue

### Drop-off Zone

If you are dropping off or picking up a student, you are welcome to use the drive-through in front of the main entrance. **Please do not park or stop for extended periods in this drive-through,** as it must be accessible to emergency vehicles.
