General Information

Kindergarten - Grade 5 Spring Break Camp

March 19 - 23 from 9:00am to 3:35pm.

Students from kindergarten to grade 2 and grades 3 to 5 choose one full-day block that runs Monday – Friday. Each block contains six classes of activities. Small class sizes ensure that students receive quality time with their teachers. Please refer to the timetable for the content of each block.

Students must bring a nut-free lunch and a snack each day.

Grades 6 - 9 Spring Break Art Intensives

Four, week-long, half-day art intensives run over the two weeks of SD #43 Spring Break and are designed specifically for youth, allowing them to delve more fully into their chosen art form. Students taking both morning and afternoon intensives should bring a nut-free lunch and snack each day.

Registration

Registration opens on **Monday, January 22**. Registration may be done online starting at 12:01am or by phone at 604.664.1636 or in person starting at 9:00am, and is on a first-come, first-served basis. **Full payment of program fees must be made at the time of registration.**

Withdrawal

A student may withdraw up to seven (7) days prior to the camp start date. A refund of the class fee will be granted less the non-refundable registration fee. Refunds will not be granted after the seven (7) day period has passed. Exceptions for medical or compassionate reasons may be considered upon receipt of a written request submitted at least 24 hours prior to the start date of the class to info@placedesarts.ca. A medical certificate may be required. Upon approval, a refund of the class fee will be granted, less the registration fee and any applicable supply fees.

Kindergarten - Grade 5: March 19 - 23

Acting Superstars

Discover the art of acting through improvisation and participating in various drama games and exercises. Release your inner superstar and learn to express yourself freely and confidently. You'll develop your performance skills while exploring new acting techniques and styles.

Learn about the creative process by planning and executing your artistic ideas. Each day, you'll work on a new aspect of a themed drawing and painting project using different tools and techniques. Capture your creativity as you discover various art techniques using pencils, paintbrushes and collage. You'll explore light, colour, shape, shading and form in this fun, hands-on art class.

Origami Mobile

Come make your own spring-themed paper mobile filled with origami creatures! Learn to fold birds, flowers and more using this ancient Japanese paper folding technique. Teacher: Sung-Eun (Sarah) Park

Paint Like the Great Masters

This class will bring the sunshine and landscapes of Cezanne, Monet and Provence into the classroom. From the techniques of Impressionism to Pointillism, we will use a variety of methods and mediums to explore and recreate the styles of these great visual art masters. Teacher: Adrian Walker

Portrait Painting

In this class, you'll explore self-expression through painting. Starting with the basics, you will learn drawing and painting techniques that will help you gain confidence in capturing the human face in tempera and acrylic paint on canvas. Teacher: Adrian Walker
