**Grade 6 - 9: March 18 - 22 & March 25 - 29: Choose from four half-day intensives over two weeks**

## General Information

### Kindergarten – Grade 5 Spring Break Camp

Students from kindergarten to grade 2 and grades 3 to 5 choose one full-day block that runs Monday – Friday. Each block contains six classes of activities. Small class sizes ensure that students receive quality time with their teachers. Please refer to the timetable for the content of each block.

*Students must bring a nut-free lunch and a snack each day.*

### Grades 6 – 9 Spring Break Intensives

Four, week-long, half-day art intensives run over the two weeks of the SD #43 Spring Break and are designed specifically for youth, allowing them to delve more fully into their chosen art form. Students taking both morning and afternoon intensives should bring a nut-free lunch and snack each day.

### Registration

Registration opens on **Monday, January 21**. Registration may be done online starting at 12:01am or by phone at 604.664.1636 or in person starting at 9:00am, and is on a first-come, first-served basis. Full payment of program fees must be made at the time of registration.

### Withdrawal

A student may withdraw up to seven (7) days prior to the camp start date. A refund of the class fee will be granted less the non-refundable registration fee. Refunds will not be granted after the seven (7) day period has passed. Exceptions for medical or compassionate reasons may be considered upon receipt of a written request submitted at least 24 hours prior to the start date of the class to [info@placedesarts.ca](mailto:info@placedesarts.ca). A medical certificate may be required. Upon approval, a refund of the class fee will be granted, less the registration fee and any applicable supply fees.

## Kindergarten – Grade 5 Camp: March 18 – 22

### Clay Play

Use your imagination and have fun creating unique clay projects. Individual exploration is encouraged as you discover cool techniques of clay. Projects will be finished with either paint or glaze to take home on Friday.

### Colourful Acrylics

Create creative and colourful paintings! In this class, learn foundational acrylic painting techniques with a focus on colour. You'll discover how to mix colours and get creative with how to use them to make two to three captivating paintings to take home.

### Dance Sampler

In this introductory all-in-one dance class, you'll explore a variety of dance styles like jazz, hip hop and breakdance. Learn fundamentals of each dance style and have fun doing it! Wear comfortable clothing you can move in.

### Drawing and Sketching

Explore drawing and sketching techniques using the elements of line, space, shape, light, shadow and texture with mediums like charcoal, pastel, ink and graphite. Apply what you learn to create art projects focusing on themes such as portraits, animals, landscapes and still life.

### Imaginative Illustrations

Are you curious about how your favourite book cover or movie character was designed? Learn to draw and paint using different illustration methods and materials. From mixed media to watercolour painting, explore different methods of drawing and painting through an illustrative lens.

### Drums Around the World

Explore drums and rhythms from around the world. Using drums, percussion and electronic instruments, learn to play along with different beats and music, synthesizers and computer software.

### Hip Hop and Breakdance

Learn the fundamentals of hip hop and breakdancing! Kick it old school with classic moves like the baby freeze, 6-step and coffee grinder, and combine these moves into a wicked dance piece. Wear comfortable clothing you can move in.

### Hip Hop Kidz

Dance to the rhythm of your favourite music and learn a dance routine that is full of flavah! Classes will include a variety of movement and coordination games and fun activities. Wear comfortable clothing you can move in.

### Intro to Piano and Rhythm Instruments

Learn to play the piano using the fun and creativity of the Music for Young Children® program. Using lovable characters, games and songs, you will discover the world of music and learn a basic understanding of how to play the piano and other rhythm instruments.

### Musical Theatre Glee Club

Practice the musical-theatre skills of acting, singing and dancing through fun games and exercises. Then, focusing on current pop songs, learn how to combine your skills in a short piece.

### Musical Theatre Stars

Learn to sing, dance and act all at once! Through games and exercises, you'll be introduced to warming up, vocal exploration, coordination and storytelling.

### Textile Arts

Immerse yourself in a variety of textile and fibre art techniques to create your own beautiful, unique treasures. Have fun participating in hands-on activities to make new projects throughout the week. You'll explore hand sewing, embroidery and more.

### Ukulele 101

Learn to sing and play along to familiar songs. Discover how the ukulele works, learn to play chords and simple melodies to go along with some of your favourite songs. You'll be introduced to note reading, rhythm and how to read basic chords. Practice ukuleles for classroom use are included.

### Watercolours and Pastels

You'll be amazed at the results when you add a twist to traditional watercolour painting. Learn the basic techniques of watercolours and both soft and oil pastels, then explore how to combine the two mediums to create interesting works of art.

### Weaving Fun

Explore the fibre arts and create your own beautiful and functional one-of-a-kind treasures. Make a new project each day: spinning and dyeing, weaving and felting, while gaining hands-on experience, developing colour sense and learning how different fibres can be transformed.
