



2019/2020 Place des Arts Student Exhibition APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Application Deadline: Wednesday, April 15, 2020

Place des Arts seeks submissions from students of all ages registered in a visual arts session class or workshop during the 2019/2020 season for the 2020 humour-themed *Place des Arts Student Exhibition* in the Atrium Gallery from **June 5-June 24, 2020** with an opening reception on **Friday, June 5 from 7:00-9:00pm**. Students are encouraged to submit humour-themed artwork (think: how humour ignites a sense of play, reveals truths and helps us to overcome hardship).

ARTWORKS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- All artworks must be original and made by the applicant; no craft kits, items purchased and assembled, imported crafts or items made by someone other than the applicant will be accepted
- Created since September 2019; submitted artworks can be made outside of Place des Arts and in a medium different than the medium of the class(es) you took at Place des Arts. For example, if you are a ceramics student, you may submit paintings
- Each artist may submit up to 2 works in any media (depending on available space, only one piece may be selected)
- All artwork must be ready to hang and/or display:
 - 2D artwork must have **hanging hardware securely attached**; [D-ring hangers](#) installed within the top ¼ of the artwork are recommended
 - Unframed pieces must have the canvas edges painted
 - Artwork(s) must be labelled with artist name and artwork title
- Artwork(s) must not have been previously exhibited at Place des Arts
- Content/subject matter is appropriate and relevant for a public space and all audiences

REVIEW PROCESS

- All submissions will be reviewed by Place des Arts and all artists will receive a confirmation email by mid-May with directions on artwork drop-off, which will occur by appointment
- Place des Arts has the sole discretion to reject any artwork(s) at any time prior to or during the exhibition

SALE OF ARTWORKS

- Place des Arts will retain 30% of the retail price of any artwork(s) sold
- A cheque for 70% of the retail price of each artwork sold during the exhibition dates will be mailed to the artist at the address indicated on the application form within thirty (30) days of the exhibition end date

LIABILITY

- Place des Arts is not liable to the artist or anyone for the loss of, or damage to, or destruction of an artwork unless such loss, damage or destruction is caused by negligence, recklessness or willful act of Place des Arts
