What you will need for 5-7yrs classes:

- 1 HB pencil
- 1 eraser
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- 20 x 26" sheets of Accent Opaque Vellum Paper, 3 sheets cut in half (available at Opus)
- Pad of construction paper
- 1 sheet of Black Poster board (cut in half)
- Watercolour Paints (set of eight or more)
- 1 soft hair flat ½" or round #12 paint brush (watercolour or acrylic)
- Oils pastels (set of 8 or more)
- Pencil crayons (set of 12 or more)
- Colour markers (set of 10 or more)
- Water container (cup or yogurt container)
- Paper Towel

What you will need 8-12yrs classes:

The supplies from the 5-7 years list above plus:

- Instead of the watercolour paints, alternatively you can get dry tempera tablets (8 colours: red, yellow, blue, green, purple, brown, white and black)
- a Deluxe Tempera Paint Tray (Although bit more expensive, Tempera paint set will last much, much longer than watercolours one)
- #6 soft hair paint brush (watercolour or acrylic)

What you will need 13-17yrs classes:

- 20 x 26" sheets of Accent Opaque Vellum Paper, 4 sheets
