What you will need:

- Watercolours, tubes are ideal but a set of pan watercolours will work too, choose any ONE belows:
  - o Paint tubes (Cotman or Winsor Newton) [Full set of Cotman Water Colour tubes for \\$55](#)
  - o Pan Travel Set (Cotman or other) [Travel set of pan watercolours \\$29](#)
  - o Prang Watercolour Pan: If you are on a tight budget you can get a Prang brand set of 16 pan watercolours, however keep in mind it may make it a bit more difficult to get a desired result. <https://www.michaels.com/prang-watercolor-pan-set/M10179163.html>
- watercolour Paper Cold Press 140 lb sheet (e.g. Arches)
- masking fluid
- paint brushes (size 0,4,8 and 12)
  - o This is a [relatively inexpensive set you can buy](#)
- a soft paint brush between  $\frac{3}{4}$ " to 2"
  - o [Here's a bamboo one from Opus](#)
- pallet, any smooth ceramic or china dinner plate (not plastic)
- 11 x 14" (min.) wood support or drawing board - at least  $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick piece of wood. [Here is an option.](#)
- paper towel
- painters tape
- table salt (Fine grain, not large crystals)
