

SUPPLY LIST

Online: Pottery and Sculpture with Noelle Horrocks

What you will need:

- A large, flat surface to work on, at least 2' x 2'
- A plastic tablecloth or heavy poster board/cardboard to cover and protect the surface you are working on; the cover should be taped/secured to your working surface
- Light plastic (e.g. a grocery bag) for covering your projects between classes
- A stable container for water (e.g. an empty yogurt container between 500-750mL)
- A larger container with warm water for rinsing hands (can be disposed of outdoors to prevent any clay from going down your sink)
- Paper towel or rag for drying your paintbrush
- Paper towel or rag to clean your hands
- Dress for mess, wear clothes you don't mind getting messy or an artist's apron
- A plastic container with a lid clearly labelled with student's first and last name (for storing works in progress and for dropping off and picking up projects from Place des Arts)
