Exploring Watercolour Painting with Cara Bain

What you need to provide:

- 1 watercolour paint set. Tubes are ideal but a set of pan watercolours will work too, choose any ONE below: Paint tubes set (Cotman or Winsor Newton), Pan travel set (Cotman or other), Prang Watercolour Pan: If you are on a tight budget you can get a Prang brand set of 16 pan watercolours, however keep in mind it may make it a bit more difficult to get a desired result.
- 1 watercolour cold press 140lb sheet of paper (e.g. Arches) Note: Please cut 22"x30" sheet, in half and then into 4 pieces 11"x15" BEFORE first class
- 1 masking fluid bottle, optional
- 4 paintbrushes, sizes 0, 4, 8, 12
- 1 paintbrush, soft, 3/4" to 2"
- 1 palette, smooth ceramic or china dinner plate (not plastic)
- 1 flat surface, 11x14 wood support or drawing board, 1/4" thick piece of wood
- 1 roll of painters tape
- paper towel
- salt, fine grain, not large crystals
- container, for water (cup or yogurt container)
