

SUPPLY LIST

Holiday Clay Magic with Noelle Horrocks

What's included:

- M340 clay

What you need to provide:

- 1 round paintbrush, synthetic #4 or any soft round brush
- variety of bamboo skewers and toothpicks, to carve into clay
- A stable container, such as an empty yogurt container between 500-750mL, with water
- Some paper towel, or a rag to dry your paintbrush
- set of acrylic paint, in a variety of colours
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 bottle of white glue
- assorted tissue paper, scraps in a variety of colours will work (we will be cutting tissue paper up into small pieces)
- Optional: item(s) to add texture, e.g., cookie cutters and/or stamps for creating shapes and patterns in clay

Online students, you will also need:

- A large, flat surface to work on, at least 2' x 2'
- A plastic tablecloth or heavy poster board to cover and protect the surface you are working on; the cover should be taped/secured to your working surface
- A larger container with warm water for rinsing hands (can be disposed of outdoors to prevent any clay from going down your sink)
- Paper towel or rag to clean your hands
