

SUPPLY LIST

So you think you can't paint in watercolour? with Dawn Livera

What you need to provide:

- 1 pencil, HB
- 1 eraser
- 1 pencil sharpener
- scissors
- 1 roll of masking tape
- 1 watercolour pencil crayon, in brown or dark grey
- 1 round paintbrush, size 6
- 1 flat paintbrush, 1/4" or 1/2"
- 1 bamboo paintbrush, size 6
- 1 palette, plastic, ceramic or plastic lids
- 1 paper pad, 9x12 watercolour, get two different types and try them both out if you like (I usually use Strathmore 140lb cold press - yellow cover)
- 8 or more paint watercolours tubes: red, blue, yellow and brown (permanent rose, cerulean blue, lemon yellow and burnt sienna) and any other colours you would like.
- 2 containers, for water (cup or yogurt container)
- paper towel, or old sponge to wipe brushes

If you already have watercolour paints and/or brushes, we can work with what you have
