

SUPPLY LIST

Exploring Watercolour Painting with Cara Bain

What's included:

- photocopies of reference materials, images, worksheets, etc., In-person students only. Online students will receive digital copies.

What you need to provide:

- Watercolour paints. Tubes are ideal but a set of Pan watercolours will work too Choose any ONE below: Paint tubes set (Cotman or Winsor Newton), Pan travel set (Cotman or other), Prang Watercolour Pan: If you are on a budget you can get a Prang brand set of 16 pan watercolours, however keep in mind it may make it a bit more difficult to get a desired result.
- 1 watercolour paper pad, cold press 140lb (e.g. Arches) *Note: Please cut the 22"x30" sheet into 4 pieces 11"x15" BEFORE first class
- 4 brushes, various sizes 0, 4, 8, 12
- 1 brush, soft, 3/4" to 2"
- 1 palette, smooth ceramic or china dinner plate (not plastic)
- 1 flat surface, 11"x14" wood support or drawing board, 1/4" thick piece of wood
- 1 roll of painters tape
- 1 roll of paper towel
- Salt: fine grain, not large crystals
- 1 container, for water (cup or yogurt container)
- 1 pencil, HB
- 1 rubber eraser
- Optional: bottle of masking fluid
