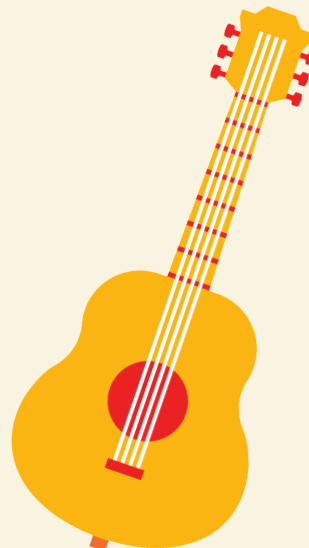

## Withdrawals

A student may withdraw up to seven (7) days prior to the camp start date. ## Camp Descriptions

### Draw and Paint: Hot Air Balloons

Learn how to draw and paint to make things look three-dimensional. By using a mix of watercolour paints and coloured pencils, paint and shade your balloons and give them a colourful design!

### Fall-Inspired Mixed Media Painting

Learn how you can use apples, sweet potatoes, cinnamon sticks, oil pastels, paint and other fun materials to create a colourful mixed media painting inspired by the fall season. Teacher: Clarissa Banos

### Hip Hop and Breakdance

Explore the fundamentals of hip hop and breakdancing! Kick it old school with classic moves like the baby freeze and learn how to pop and lock, then combine the moves into a wicked piece! Wear comfortable clothing you can move in and non-marking running shoes or bare feet. Teacher: Ashley Binette

### Hip Hop Kids

Dance to the rhythm and learn some moves from a variety of hip hop styles! Classes include a variety of movement and coordination games and fun activities. Wear comfortable clothing you can move in and non-marking running shoes or bare feet. Teacher: Ashley Binette

### Hot Air Balloon Art Adventure

Using watercolours, pastels, string and scissors, create hot air balloon designs! Teacher: Cara Bain

### Itsy Bitsy Yarn Spiders

With chenille stems and yarn, learn how to create a giant, colourful spider decoration using fibre art techniques. Teacher: Catherine Dumaine

### Making Magical Maps

Transform an old sailor's map into a map designed by you using mixed media materials like paper, vintage magazines, stickers, drawing materials and acrylic paint. Create a pirate treasure map with the destination being creative expression. Teacher: Cyd Eva

### Mixed Media Monoprinting

Learn about monoprinting and apply the techniques to create a layered monoprint image using an assortment of materials. Teacher: Tami Murray

### Musical Theatre Fun

Learn to dance, sing and act in this lively class! Play fun, interactive drama games and learn physical and vocal warm-ups. Then dive into the basics of musical theatre including character development, coordination and storytelling. Using popular musical theatre songs and routines, combine your skills and find out what it takes to be a performer! Teacher: Joanna Kovats

### Origami Pumpkin Farm

Develop your creativity and refine your motor skills with the art of origami. Make an origami pumpkin farm filled with pumpkins, spiders, ghosts and a black cat. Teacher: Sarah Park

### Spooky Origami Castle

Develop your creativity and refine your motor skills with the art of origami. Make an origami castle filled with paper ghosts, spiders and bats. Teacher: Sarah (Sung-Eun) Park
