Students choose one full-day block (six classes).

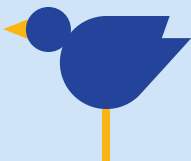
March 23 – 27, 2026 • K-Grade 2

Class Descriptions

Drums & Rhythm

Immerse yourself in music from around the world and learn the basics of making music through drumming and rhythm. Instruments provided, tap into your musical spirit! Teacher: Jason Overy

Drawing Imaginary Creatures

Starting from a unique creative exercise, conjure up your own imaginary creature in all its strangeness and splendour. Use your imagination in combination with animal anatomy and an array of artistic techniques to develop your creature. Teacher: Riley O'Neill

Felted Pet Rock

Try your hand at wet felting using natural sheep's fleece to create a pet rock - the perfect easy-care pet. With some tender love and care you and your pet rock can be best friends forever! Care and feeding instructions included. Teacher: Catherine Dumaine

Hip Hop Kids

Dance to the rhythm of the music and learn some moves from a variety of hip-hop styles! Explore different movement and coordination games and fun activities. Wear comfortable clothing you can move in and non-marking, indoor running shoes or bare feet. Teacher: Ashley Binette

Improvised Stories & Scenes

Dive into character creation through fun ice breakers and interactive warm-ups. Explore movement, voice, and expression to bring unique characters to life. Once our cast is ready, we'll jump into a collaborative storytelling adventure, using improvisation to build scenes and shape a one-of-a-kind play. Mixed Media: Pirate Treasure Map
