Removing Financial Barriers

At Place des Arts, we believe everyone should have the opportunity to experience and participate in the arts. Our goal is to make our programs and events as accessible as possible, regardless of financial circumstances.

To support this aim, we raise funds through corporate sponsorships, grants, donations and our annual online auction (October 18 - November 4, 2025). These funds help support bursaries, program subsidies, and a range of low-cost and no-cost programs and events, making it easier for individuals and families to engage in the arts.

Bursaries

Bursary applications are accepted throughout the year; the deadline to receive an application is six weeks before the start date of the class or lesson to which the bursary will be applied.

- Our *Creative HeARTs* program offers free art workshops for newcomers to Canada.
- Our fully subsidized Summer Theatre Troupe program gives aspiring youth actors the opportunity to perform a live show for the public.
- Flying Colours is a free, week-long, half-day multidisciplinary art camp for children aged 7 to 11 with developmental and/or physical disabilities.

Program Types, Fees and Registration Information

Private Lessons: Offered September to June

Offered in music and dance, and upon request, visual arts and theatre, private lessons provide personalized, one-on-one instruction tailored to each student's needs and schedule.

Private lessons remain open for registration throughout the season.

How to Register:

- In person or by phone (no online registration).
- Or complete an **Interest to Register Form** at <u>placedesarts.ca/registration-interest-form/</u>.

Lesson Fees: Fees vary by teacher and start at \$30 per 30-minute lesson.

Registration Fee: \$45 per enrolment

September-June Classes: Up to 39 weekly classes per season

These continuous programs, offered in music, dance, and through our Coquitlam Youth Theatre programs, run from September to June and promote steady progress. Students remain with the same class throughout the season.

How to Register: Online, by phone, or in person

Class Fees: Fees vary by program type and discipline and are based on a per-class fee structure.

Registration Fee: \$45 per enrolment

Supply Fees: If applicable, they are charged to cover the cost of materials and/or equipment used in the class.

Production Fees and Deposits: These are applied to dance classes participating in the year-end dance recital or competitions (see pg. 14) and all of the Coquitlam Youth Theatre Programs (see pg. 27).

Fall/Winter/Spring Session Classes and Workshops:

Session classes run anywhere from 4-12 weeks; workshops typically run for 1-3 days:

Fall Session: Sep 21 - Dec 13
Winter Session: Jan 11 - Mar 7
Spring Session: Apr 7 - Jun 13

Session classes are offered in all disciplines, are shorter term and build skills week to week.

Workshops focus on the development of specific skills or are project-based in nature.

How to Register: Online, by phone, or in person.

Class Fees: Fees vary by program type and discipline and are based on a per-class fee structure.

Registration Fee: included in the total cost of the class.

- \$15 per session class enrolment
- \$5 per workshop enrolment

Supply Fees: May be included in the total cost. If not, a supply list will be provided, and students must purchase supplies before the class starts.

Payment Policies

Fees Policy

- Payment of all class and lesson fees, registration fees, supply fees, production fees and deposits is due at the time of enrolment.
- A pre-authorized payment plan option is available with a valid credit card for September-June class fees and Private Lesson fees (charged on the first of each month). For our Coquitlam Youth Theatre Programs, the pre-authorized payment plan is charged on Sep 1 and Oct 1.
- All registration fees are non-refundable.
 Registration fees are applied to all enrolment transactions and cover costs relating to administering client accounts, registration software fees and studio and equipment maintenance (e.g. sound systems, pianos, kilns, studio tables and chairs).

- Students are not considered enrolled until payment has been received. A verbal agreement with a teacher does not constitute registration.
- Enrolments are non-transferable. A student's place in a class or lesson cannot be transferred to another individual.

GST

GST is charged on all class and private lesson fees, and registration fees for students ages 15 years and over (excluding music).

Failed Payments

A \$15 service fee will be charged for failed pre-authorized monthly payments.

Enrolment Modification Fee for September-June Classes or Private Lessons

One schedule change is allowed per student, per season with the same teacher. (e.g., changing the day, time, or class).

For example:

• Moving from a Wednesday class to a Friday class taught by the same teacher.

A \$15 service fee will be charged for each additional change initiated by the student.

Trial private lessons may be rescheduled once without loss of payment provided you give at least 48 hours' notice and stay with the same teacher.

Participation & Attendance

Start Date Reminders

We do not send email or text reminders about start dates and times. Please check your registration receipts or your online client account to view your schedule.

Absences - Classes/Workshops

Reporting absences is optional, but we do not follow up on prolonged or unreported student absences.

Absences - Private Lessons

Please notify the registration desk or your teacher as early as possible, if you will be absent.

Illness

Students who are unwell or experiencing cold or flu symptoms should not attend. Refunds or make-ups are not offered for missed classes or lessons.

Age Policy

Our classes are organized according to the developmental abilities of each age group. Students must meet the minimum and maximum age requirements specified for each class.

REFUNDS

Refunds apply to Private Lessons and all program types, which include:

- · September-June Classes.
- Session Classes (fall, winter, spring, summer).
- Coquitlam Youth Theatre programs.
- Workshops.
- Art Camps (Pro-D Day, Spring Break and Summer Fun!).

Non-Refundable Fees

- Registration fees are non-refundable unless Place des Arts cancels a program.
- Online Processing Fees: All enrolments processed online are subject to a non-refundable processing fee, calculated based on the enrolment cost. This fee is charged and collected by Active Network Inc., Place des Arts' online registration software provider. As the fee is retained by Active Network and not refunded to Place des Arts, it cannot be refunded in the event of withdrawals or cancellations.

Full Refunds

A full refund (class fees, registration fee and any supply fees, production fees and deposits) will be issued when:

- The program is cancelled by Place des Arts before the start date. (See Cancellations).
- Note: online processing fees are non-refundable.

Partial Refunds

A refund (minus registration and online processing fees) will be issued when:

- The program is cancelled by Place des Arts after the start date. (See Cancellations).
- A student withdraws before the applicable withdrawal deadline. (See Withdrawals).

Refunds for Individual Classes or Private Lessons

Refunds will be issued when:

• A class or private lesson is cancelled due to teacher absence or facility closure and no make-up is scheduled. (See Cancellations).

No Refunds

Refunds will not be issued when:

- A student withdraws after the withdrawal deadline. (See Withdrawals).
- A student misses one or more class(es) or private lesson(s) for any reason including, but not limited to, lateness, illness, vacation or scheduling. Note: Private lesson teachers are not obligated to offer a make-up lesson in these cases.

CANCELLATIONS

Place des Arts reserves the right to cancel a program **before the start date** due to insufficient enrolment. If this occurs, students or parents will be notified at least 48 hours in advance.

Place des Arts may also cancel a program **after the start date** if enrolment falls below the minimum requirement.

In either case, we will do our best to offer an alternative program. If no suitable alternative is available, a full or partial refund will be issued.

Please note: Online processing fees are non-refundable.

If a class or private lesson is cancelled due to teacher absence or facility closure, Place des Arts will either:

- Schedule a make-up or
- Issue a refund for the cancelled class or private lesson.

If a make-up is not possible, or the student is unavailable to attend it, a refund of the cancelled class or private lesson will be issued.

WITHDRAWALS

Requests received before the applicable withdrawal deadline will be eligible for a refund minus any non-refundable fees or deposits, including online processing fees.

No refunds will be granted after the withdrawal deadline has passed.

Withdrawal Deadlines by Program Type

Session Classes (fall, winter, spring), Workshops, Art Camps:

Withdraw up to seven (7) days before the start date.

- Class fees and supply fees will be refunded.
- Registration fees and online processing fees are non-refundable.

Private Lessons:

Withdraw any time

- A withdrawal fee equal to one lesson fee will be charged.
- Any remaining lesson fees or any remaining post-dated payments will be cancelled.
- Registration fees are non-refundable.

Trial Private Lessons:

Withdraw up to two (2) days before the scheduled date.

September-June Music & Dance Classes (also applies to January-June Dance Sampler Class):

Withdraw any time.

- A withdrawal fee equal to one class fee will be charged.
- Any remaining class fees will be refunded, or any remaining post-dated payments will be cancelled.
- Registration fees, supply fees and online processing fees are non-refundable.
- The dance recital production fee, video fee and any deposits will be refunded if notice to withdraw is given on or before October 31, 2025 (or February 28, 2026 for the Jan-Jun Dance Sampler classes).

Coquitlam Youth Theatre (CYT) Programs:

Withdraw on or before September 30, 2025.

- After the last attended class, remaining class fees and the production fee will be refunded.
- Registration fees and online processing fees are non-refundable.

Musical Rainbow

3 1/2 - 8 years

In this innovative children's program, students learn the principles of music through singing songs, chanting rhymes, playing music games, and using xylophones, recorders and other instruments. This program is based on the Kodály philosophy along with elements of Orff and Suzuki methodology. Note-reading, writing and music history are taught at the upper levels. Gain a solid understanding of music and develop a strong foundation for children to study music at an older age.

• In the **Red level** (Preschool, 3 ½ - 4 ½ years), students begin by building a repertoire of musical experiences. The songs and rhymes learned will be used to inform musical concepts in later years. The goal is to have a fun, positive experience in music in a group setting. Concepts such as music beat, fast/slow, loud/soft and higher/lower pitches are explored.





Scholarships



Each year, Place des Arts awards a variety of scholarships to assist students in their studies in the visual, literary and performing arts.
Scholarships are awarded to students in recognition of artistic excellence, achievement and/or overcoming a personal challenge. Visit placedesarts.ca/scholarships-and-bursaries to find our scholarship guidelines and to apply.

Place des Arts Scholarships

These scholarships are open to students ages 9-12 (junior category) and 13+ who are registered in music, dance, theatre, literary or visual arts classes at Place des Arts.

Scholarship for Advanced Musical Studies

Place des Arts' Scholarship for Advanced Musical Studies is awarded annually and is open to all music students working toward their grade 10 or ARCT (or equivalent) levels.

This award helps offset the expenses of senior musical studies and provides students with an extra incentive to continue with their education.

Elliott Harty Piano Scholarship

Elliott Harty studied piano at Place des Arts for 7 years. He was due to take his grade 9 piano exam on the day he died due to a tragic motorcycle accident on June 4, 2007, at age 17. To honour his memory, his family, friends and Place des Arts established the Elliott Harty Piano Scholarship. Each year it is awarded to the Place des Arts piano student aged 12 and up who has shown the greatest improvement over the year.

Fern Bouvier Arts Legacy Award

Named after Place des Arts' founder and long-time board president Fern Bouvier, this award recognizes an advanced Place des Arts student studying in any artistic discipline who intends to pursue their arts education at a professional or post-secondary institution and has a long-term connection to Place des Arts.

Don Portelance Scholarship for Advanced Visual Arts Studies

A master artist and teacher, Don Portelance has taught gifted young artists at Place des Arts for over 30 years. This award recognizes an intermediate or advanced Place des Arts teen or adult visual arts student/emerging artist who is actively developing their art practice with the intention of continuing their studies in the visual arts and/or creating a body of work.

Leonore Peyton Memorial Award

This award was established in memory of Leonore Peyton, former Place des Arts Executive Director and founding member, and is open to a student studying in any discipline.

W.H. Sclater Memorial Scholarship

Born in New Westminster, Bill Sclater was well-known for his adult and children's visual arts classes. This scholarship is presented annually to a student aged 7 and up at Place des Arts to encourage their studies and growth in visual arts.
