REQUIREMENTS

- All teachers are required to obtain and provide a Police Information Check with a vulnerable sector screening prior to providing teaching services.
- Teachers are required to submit class proposals for consideration.
- Teachers are not employees of Place des Arts and as such are required to work independently within the Place des Arts structure and administrative support provided.
