

Agamographs and Pop-up Art

Create an 'agamograph' – a picture that changes when you look at it from different angles. Explore pop-up art which is a type of three-dimensional art that 'pops up' into a mini paper sculpture. Get ready to incorporate a variety of recycled materials and natural elements, including cardboard, egg cartons, juice jugs, rocks, twigs, feathers and more into your colourful artwork. Create a garden mosaic, a birdhouse, a flower bouquet, a butterfly mobile, a floral sun-catcher and so much more! Teacher: Clarissa Banos

Watercolour Explorations

Make a splash with watercolour paints. Explore gilded insects, watch vibrant ink dance into puddles of water, layer paint to show space and discover awesome resist techniques and more. Teacher: Tami Murray

World of Drums

Learn to play drums and percussion instruments from around the world! Taiko Drums from Japan, hand drums from Africa, Latin America, the Middle East and Brazil, the snare drum and all the bells and whistles that accompany world music are explored. Explore music basics through rhythm and vocal games, then build your sound with synthesizers and computers. Explore your inner drummer! Teacher: Jason Overy

World of Guitar

Learn basic guitar techniques while exploring musical cultures from around the world. Expressive Arts

Hone your drawing and painting skills, learn about contrast, negative space, composition and more while looking for inspiration in unusual places like your name, feet or a mirror. The week will include word games, movement and modelling with polymer clay. Express yourself in this dynamic, engaging class for bold and reflective artists alike. Teacher: Lena Savic

Fibre Explorations

Learn about fibres and their uses while creating beautiful, handmade projects. Explore a variety of techniques such as spinning and dyeing, weaving on a table loom, wet felting and more. Teacher: Catherine Dumaine

Hand-Drawn Animation

Explore animation from its basic principles and techniques to its unique capabilities as a storytelling medium. By the end of the week a short animation will be created. Finished projects will be emailed to families approximately three weeks after the class end date. Teacher: Riley O'Neill

Surreal Illustrations

Dive into the dreamlike world of Surrealism by conjuring up your own imaginary creatures, places and objects in all of their strangeness and splendour. Learn the history of Surrealism through creative exercises and explore the dynamic possibilities through a variety of delightful illustration techniques. Teacher: Riley O'Neill

Theatre Club

If you love to perform, or want to learn, join the Theatre Club! Deepen your understanding of self and others by expanding your theatrical knowledge and skill. You will work collaboratively on a short 10-minute script, bringing to life a variety of characters, memorizing lines, creating physicality and exploring voice techniques. Upcycle Denim Jackets

Upcycle clothing to make fierce fashion statements and express yourself. Learn about local and international upcycling designers and the sustainable movement Fashion Revolution. Learn textile painting, make patches and paint your own denim jacket. Basic materials will be provided but students are encouraged to bring clothing & materials to upcycle in class. Teacher: Cyd Eva
