- Work cooperatively with Camp Staff and teachers to create a support schedule to ensure all identified students are supported.
- Visit identified classrooms in the centre to assist students who require positive behavioural support in the classroom, during transitions and breaks.
- Provide verbal status reports regarding student support to the Camp Staff Team.
- Reinforce Place des Arts' "FISH" policy behaviour values:

 - Include Everyone
 - o **S**how Respect
 - Help Each Other
- Assist with ensuring safe student arrival and departure.
- Reinforce Place des Arts' health and safety protocols.
- Provide engagement activities during break times throughout the day.

- Completion or working toward completion of a Special Education Assistant Certificate/Diploma (or equivalent education and/or work experience).
- Previous experience working with children aged 5-11 with support needs and/or behavioural challenges in a field related to education and/or childcare.
