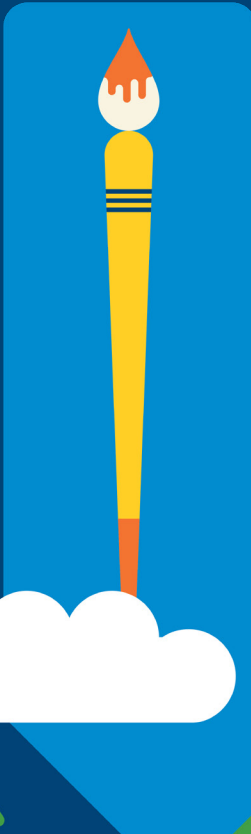
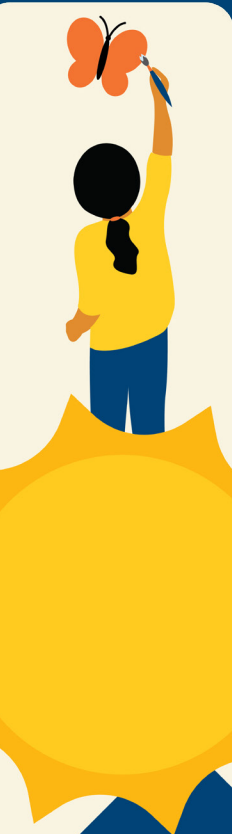

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# Registration Information

Registration for our summer programs begins on **Sunday, April 12, 2026 at 7:00 AM online** and at **1:00 PM in person and by phone**.

## Register Online

Online registration opens at 7:00 AM on Sunday, April 12, 2026. Registration day can be very busy. We strongly advise parents/guardians to visit our website prior to registration opening, to familiarize themselves with the registration process. ## Non-refundable online processing fee

All online enrolments are subject to a non-refundable processing fee (calculation based on enrolment cost) charged by Active Network Ltd., our online registration software provider.

Place des Arts cannot refund this processing fee for withdrawals or cancellations since it is not refunded to Place des Arts by ActiveNet.

# Summer Fun! Camp Withdrawals • Cancellations • Age Policy



## Withdrawals

A student may withdraw up to seven (7) days before the camp start date. A request to withdraw must be submitted by email to [info@placedesarts.ca](mailto:info@placedesarts.ca), over the phone at 604.664.1636 ext. 0 or in-person to the registration desk. Requests received before the withdrawal deadline will be eligible for a refund minus the non-refundable registration and online processing fees.

No refunds will be granted after the seven (7) day period has passed. We may consider exceptions for medical or compassionate reasons, at our sole discretion.

## Lunchtime Camp Care Withdrawals

Lunchtime Camp Care is non-refundable and non-transferable. However, if the student is withdrawing from the entire camp, the Summer Fun! Camps' withdrawal policy applies.

## Cancellations

Place des Arts reserves the right to cancel a camp before the start date due to insufficient enrolment. If this occurs, students or parents will be notified at least 48 hours in advance.

Place des Arts may also cancel a camp after the start date if enrolment falls below the minimum requirement.

In either case, we will do our best to offer an alternative camp. If no suitable alternative is available, a full or partial refund will be issued.

Please note: online processing fees are non-refundable.

## Missed Camps

No refunds will be granted for camps missed by the student for reasons including, but not limited to, illness, scheduling conflicts and/or vacation.

Please note that we do not follow up with students who are absent.

## Age Policy

Our Summer Fun! camps are organized according to the developmental abilities of each age group. Students must meet the minimum and maximum age requirements specified for each class. By adhering to set age groups, we ensure a quality experience for all students in the camp.

### Half Day Camps

**5-6 years:** Student must turn 5 or still be 6 by the Friday of the week the camp takes place.

**7-8 years:** Student must turn 7 or still be 8 by the Friday of the week the camp takes place.

**9-12 years:** Student must turn 9 or still be 12 by the Friday of the week the camp takes place.

**11-14 years:** Student must turn 11 or still be 14 by the Friday of the week the camp takes place.

### Day Camps

**7-9 years:** Student must turn 7 or still be 9 by the Friday of the week the camp takes place.

# Camp Behaviour Policy • Support Needs & Health Concerns

It is our goal for all students attending camps to have the best experience possible in a warm and welcoming environment. To promote consistent behaviour expectations among students, we use the “**FISH**” policy. We recommend reviewing the FISH policy with your camper.

**F** = Follow instructions

**I** = Include everyone

**S** = Show respect

**H** = Help each other

**1. Verbal warning:** Our first response will be a verbal intervention to help the student understand the impact their behaviour is having on others.

**2. Supervised time out:** If the behaviour continues, the student will be removed from the program for a supervised time out. The student’s parent/guardian will be notified of the incident and

will be asked to review the behaviour policy with the student.

**3. Pick-up:** If the behaviour continues, the parent/guardian will be contacted and asked to pick up the student immediately with the student missing the rest of the day.

**4. Dismissal:** A student may be dismissed if their behaviour prevents safe and effective participation in our programs. Dismissal may occur after consultation between the parent/guardian, student, program staff and Place des Arts’ Executive Director. No refunds will be granted.

**Note:** Place des Arts has the discretion to dismiss a student immediately under appropriate circumstances.



## Health Concerns

- Prior to the start of the student’s camp, please inform us of any health concerns, including food allergies or support needs, by adding relevant details to the Medical Alert section on the student’s account and/or emailing us at [summercamp@placedesarts.ca](mailto:summercamp@placedesarts.ca). Providing this information in advance helps promote a safer and more successful experience for students.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for administering any medications required by the student. While our staff are First Aid trained, they are **not** permitted to administer medication except an EpiPen in an emergency. If the student has an EpiPen, they must carry it on their person at all times. EpiPens cannot be stored in a backpack. Alternatively, EpiPens can be labelled with the student’s name and left with staff at the time of sign-in. # Summer Fun! Half-Day Camp Overview



## Half-Day Camps for 5-6, 7-8 & 9-12 years

Each Half-Day block includes three 55-minute classes in the visual and/or performing arts. Each block has a maximum of 11 campers.

## Half-Day Youth Camps for 11-14 years

Half-Day Youth Camps for 11-14 years are offered both in the morning and afternoon, offering a variety of art forms, such as visual arts, music, theatre and literary arts!

## Lunchtime Camp Care (12:05-12:40 PM)

Campers aged 5-14 registered for both the morning and afternoon Half Day Camps must also register for Lunchtime Camp Care for an additional cost (\$35 per week or \$28 for week 5). Pre-registration is required. Bring a nut-free lunch and water bottle each day. Lunchtime Camp Care is held outside, weather permitting. **Campers are encouraged to bring towels** to sit on while outside. See the camp grids on [pages 7-18](#) for details.

## Day Camps for 7-9 years

Each Day Camp block includes a half-day visual arts class and a half-day performing arts class. Each camp has a maximum of 11 campers. All supplies are provided.

Outdoor activities may occur during the week and will be supervised, taking place within walking distance of Place des Arts. Lunch and break times will be held outside, weather permitting. **Campers are encouraged to bring towels** to sit on while outside.

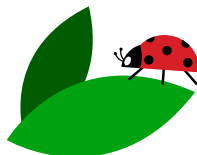
## Can someone else pick up a student from camp?
